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

Leukaemia – Haematopoiesis


- Formation of blood cells
- Haematopoietic system
 - Bone marrow, Liver, Spleen, LN's, Thymus





Leukaemia - Definition


- Defect in process of haematopoiesis
- Can occur at different points in pathway
- Leads to accumulation of precursor cells in bone marrow and blood



Leukaemia – Classification

Acute


- Problem is early on in haematopoiesis pathway
- Build up of premature cells (blasts) in bone marrow and blood
- Can be acutely fatal



Leukaemia – Classification

Chronic

- Problem is late on in haematopoiesis pathway
- Does not always need treatment
- Difficult to cure



Leukaemia – Symptoms and signs

Acute

- Bone marrow failure
 - ▶ Low RBC → anaemia
 - ▶ Low WBC → infection
 - ▶ Low Platelets → bleeding
 - ☐ Mucosal bleeding (epistaxis, subconjunctival hge)
 - □ Purpura
- Infiltration of organs by malignant cells
 - Leads to lymphadenopathy
 - Hepatosplenomegaly
- Weight loss, fever, gout



Leukaemia – Symptoms and signs

Chronic

- Non specific symptoms
 - Weight loss, fever, lethargy
- Lymphadenopathy and Hepatosplenomegaly
 - ▶ Common
- Bone marrow failure is rare
