The project will last for four years until March 2012 and will include also a stronger focus on the northern regions of Ghana. MIDA Ghana III will be implemented in close collaboration with the Ministry of Health and Ghana Health Service. I will provide you with more details soon and also let you know when operations will start. The project will officially be launched during the second half of April.
