

MOTEC'S GESTURE OF SOLIDARITY WITH DISASTER VICTIMS AND TARGET HOSPITALS IN GHANA.

Motec Life – UK has made a token donation of about 100 blankets to the National Catholic Secretariat in Accra towards disaster victims. The materials were presented to the Secretariat during Motec's April working visit to Ghana. There were no official ceremonies as Motec considered the offer as a small gesture of solidarity with disaster victims.
