

## Motec at Nkawkaw in October 2012

Motec has conducted a two day educational workshop for staff of Holy Family Hospital and also delivered lectures at the Nursing College at Nkawkaw. The educational programme included pain control, 'breast health', management of medical emergencies, infection control, wound care and empowerment of patients in participating in their care in chronic disease conditions.

The entire hospital staff enjoyed split sessions of training and education during the campaign in October 2012 by Motec. On behalf of IOM-Motec, books worth about £500 and other educational materials were donated to the Nurse College by the executives of Motec, Dr Raymond Ofori and Mr Ofori-Atta. Also training materials used in the workshop for managing labour including foetoscopes and foetoscopes, blood pressure monitors and foetal Dopplers worth several hundreds of pounds were also donated to the hospital's medical director for use by Maternity Unit. About 9 Motec volunteers in total participated in the teaching programme.

The change in the teaching programme at Nkawkaw from formal lectures to workshop style for staff has proved very popular. Other teaching programme for 2013 for the staff and students are under discussion.
