

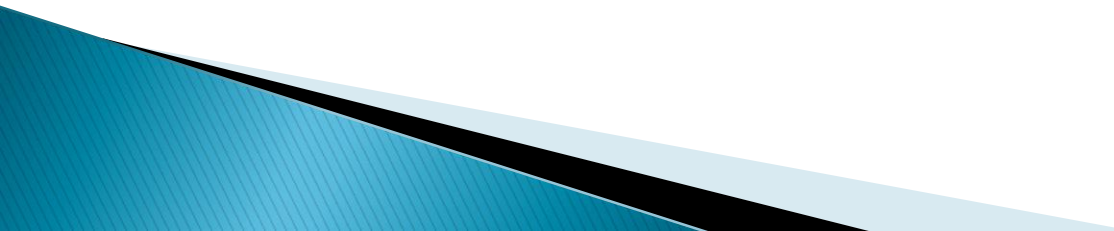
# ANNUAL REPORT- NUWLIFE PROJECT

## PROJECT AIMS- SUMMERY

- ▶ Teaching mothers on nutrition using local food and vegetables
  - ▶ Making farming land available to parents from which they can grow food and sell some to better their financial status
  - ▶ Establishing a nutrition rehabilitation centre in the hospital where mother will be taught health and nutrition
  - ▶ Setting up of income generating centre where mothers, while attending to their children, will also learn an income generating activity from which they can generate some level of income when discharged from the centre.


# ANNUAL REPORT– NUWLIFE PROJECT



## CHALLENGES

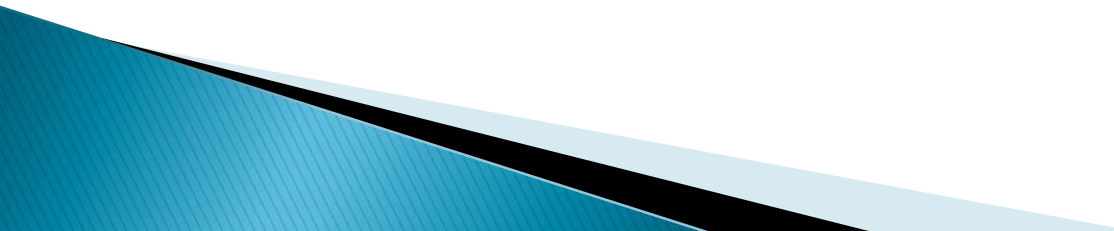
- ▶ Slow progress
